PRINCIPLES

- The Fund's objective is to maximize social impact while providing a market rate financial return.
- Financial return and social impact will be measured, projected, tracked and reported.
- Investments are made solely in the 8 counties of WNY.
- The Fund commits to be flexible, responsive and supportive of current and potential investees.
- The Fund will assist in cultivating a larger impact investing ecosystem in WNY.



- Take on higher risk with trusted teams in the early stages to allow for long term growth.



LESSONS LEARNED: SOCIAL IMPACT

- 100% of investments have addressed 3 or more social impact targets.
- DEI lens is applied across portfolio and investment process.
- Neighborhood investments include urban Buffalo and agricultural regions of WNY.
- Strong reputation and demonstrated commitment to serving identified marginalized communities and groups.
