Resource Sharing

We will promptly publish all significant results in compliance with NIH openaccess policy with thoroughly detailed procedures and protocols (see also the Data Management and Sharing Plan). As appropriate, we will also deposit data in public databases, such as the Protein Data Bank (for the coordinates of structures determined) and the PRIDE repository of the ProteomeXchange Consortium (for proteomics data). Upon request from other academic/non-profit investigators, we will provide all reagents, small molecules, probes, vectors, and cell strains generated in this project to the requestors, subject (where appropriate) to completion of a materials transfer agreement with Vanderbilt University and payment of any significant costs incurred in satisfying the request (a need for the latter being very rare). Generally, valuable protocols will also be posted on the Lab website, as we have done for many years.
