Applications are sought from candidates with primary experience in one or more of the following fields: transportation engineering, system analysis, or logistics; geographic information systems (GIS); or computer science with a focus on database systems. There are currently several research projects ongoing in which the post-doctoral fellow may be involved. These include intermodal freight transportation, risk management, infrastructure adaptation, GIS network analysis, and transportation information management.

The post-doctoral fellow will function as an integral member of a growing research group. The group is led by three faculty members. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to existing projects, work closely with other members of the research group and in interdisciplinary teams, help develop project proposals and publish research results in peer-reviewed journals.

Qualifications:

A Ph.D. in Civil Engineering or a related field (e.g., Logistics, Industrial Engineering, Systems Engineering, or Computer Science) is required. In addition, candidates should have a keen interest and demonstrated expertise in their particular field, strong interpersonal skills, mature writing ability, capability of performing in-depth data analyses, and experience in database management and design, GIS and web/software development (ASP.NET, VB.NET skills preferred). Candidates must be self-starters who are comfortable taking initiative and who can play a major role in working on multiple projects and bringing them to completion.
