	Applicant must be currently enrolled in one of Vanderbilt's partner institutions
	Applicant must be nominated by their home institution to participate in the Vanderbilt
	University Undergraduate Exchange program
	Applicant must have a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application
	Applicant whose first language or language of instruction is not English must provide proof of their English language proficiency. Minimum scores of 100 on internet-based TOEFL, 7.0 on the IELTS and 70 on the PTE Academic test are recommended. *Applicants from some partner institutions are exempt from this requirement. Please check with your home institution to verify All application materials must be received by the deadline: March 1st (fall and academic year)
