

Vanderbilt University's Survey on Hybrid/Remote Work: VU Future of Work Survey

Survey Overview

Administered from October 20th to November 5th, 2021, Vanderbilt's Survey on Hybrid/Remote Work was distributed to 2,659 eligible employees and received 1,755 responses (a response rate of 66%). The respondent profile closely resembles the overall population of eligible employees (See the last section of the results). In addition to inquiring about current and preferred work arrangements, the survey included items focused on four primary topics: employee's experiences managing work and personal life; employee's sentiments as a Vanderbilt employee; employee's experiences with their department, their team, and the institution; employee's reflections on location for conducting and completing various aspects of work.

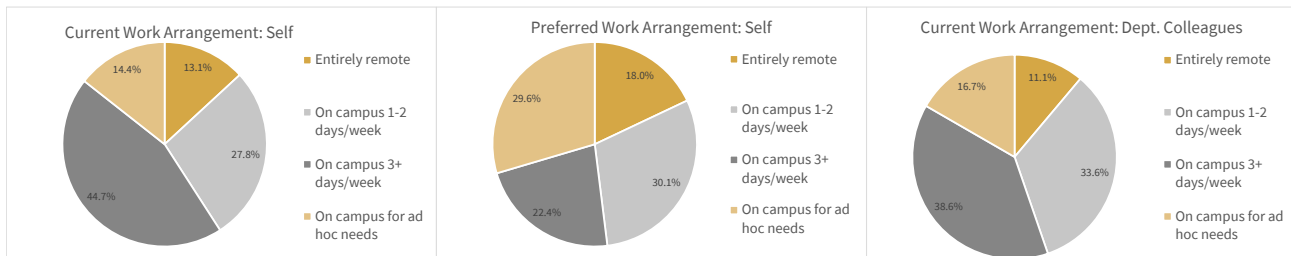

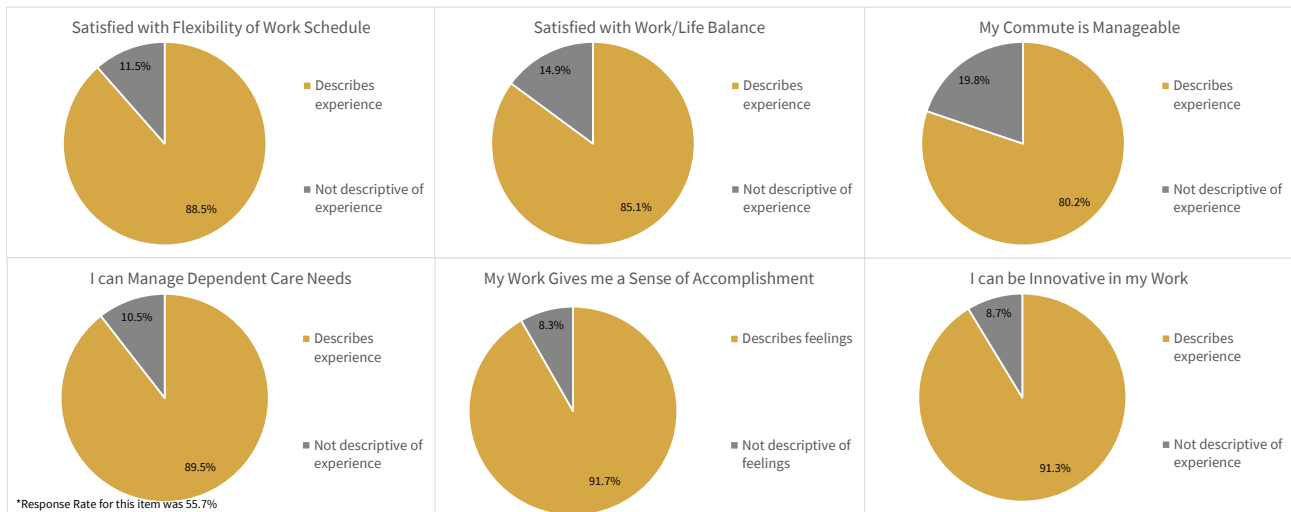

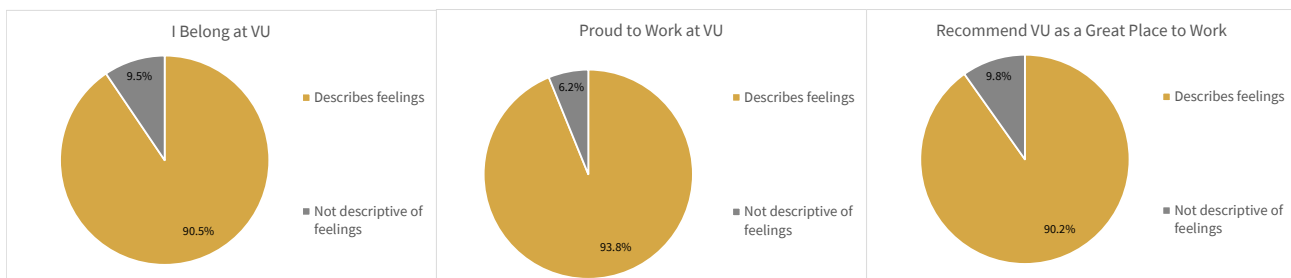
Work Arrangements



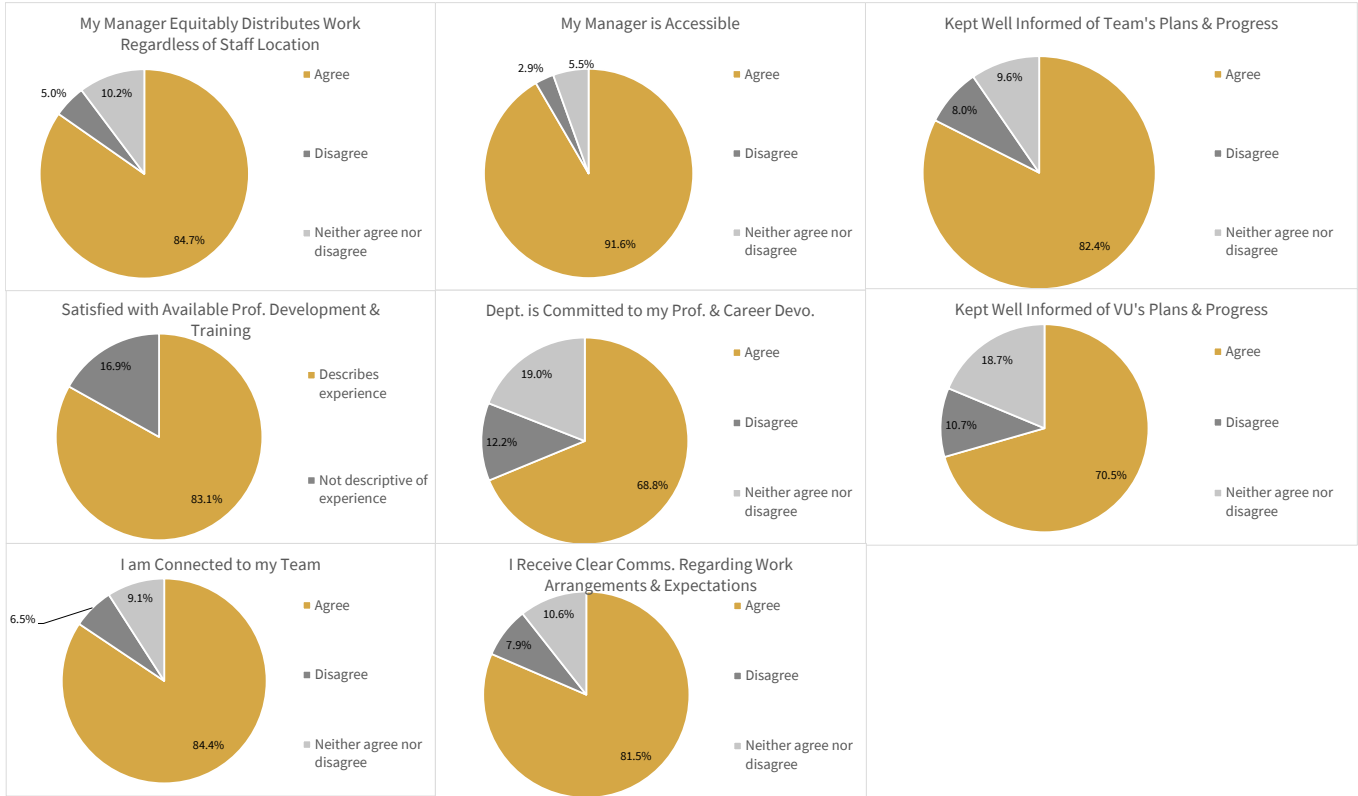
Ratings of Work Related Attributes / Work Life Balance
