vocab to know

neurodiversity, noun

refers to the variety of ways that human minds are wired, and specifically to the idea that there are certain neurological differences which confer both challenges and gifts

In a sentence: Many businesses have found that having neurodiversity among employees can be an asset.

neurodivergent, adjective

describing a person whose brain is neurologically atypical

In a sentence: A neurodivergent person may be more likely to think visually.

neurotypical, adjective & noun

(adj) describing a person who is neurologically typical OR (noun) a person who is neurologically typical

In a sentence: A neurotypical (adj) person may be less likely to notice small details.

My brother is a neurotypical (noun).
