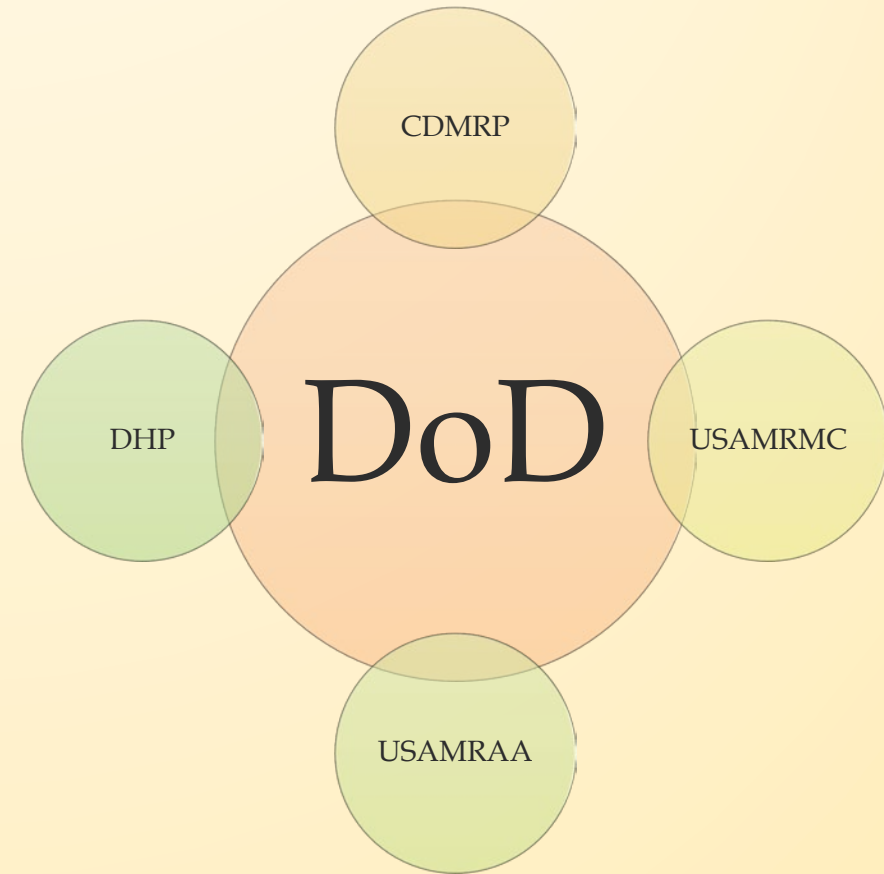

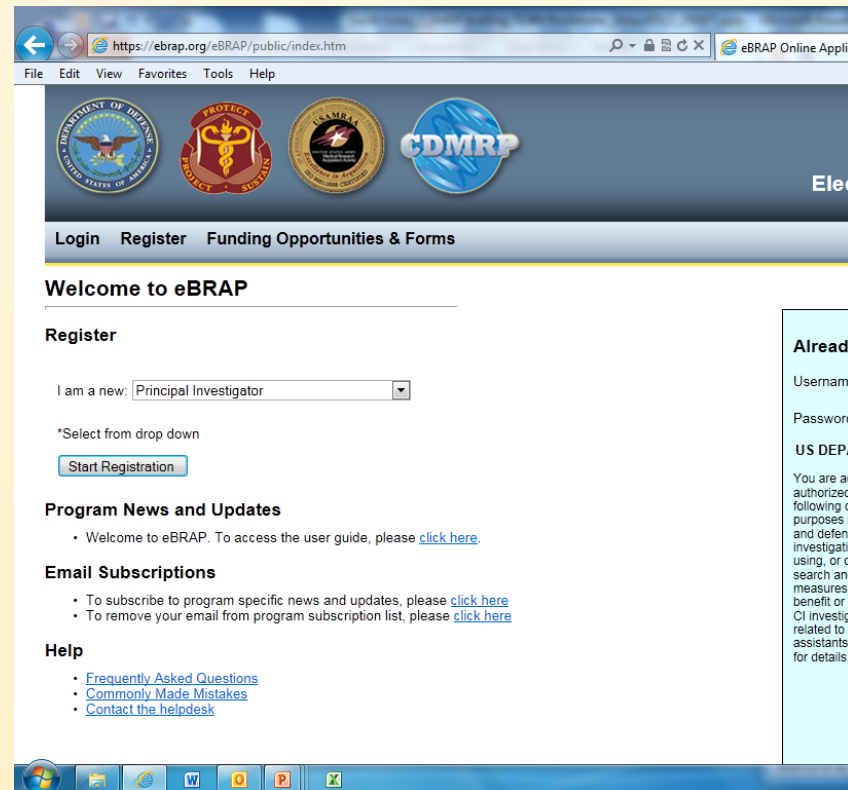

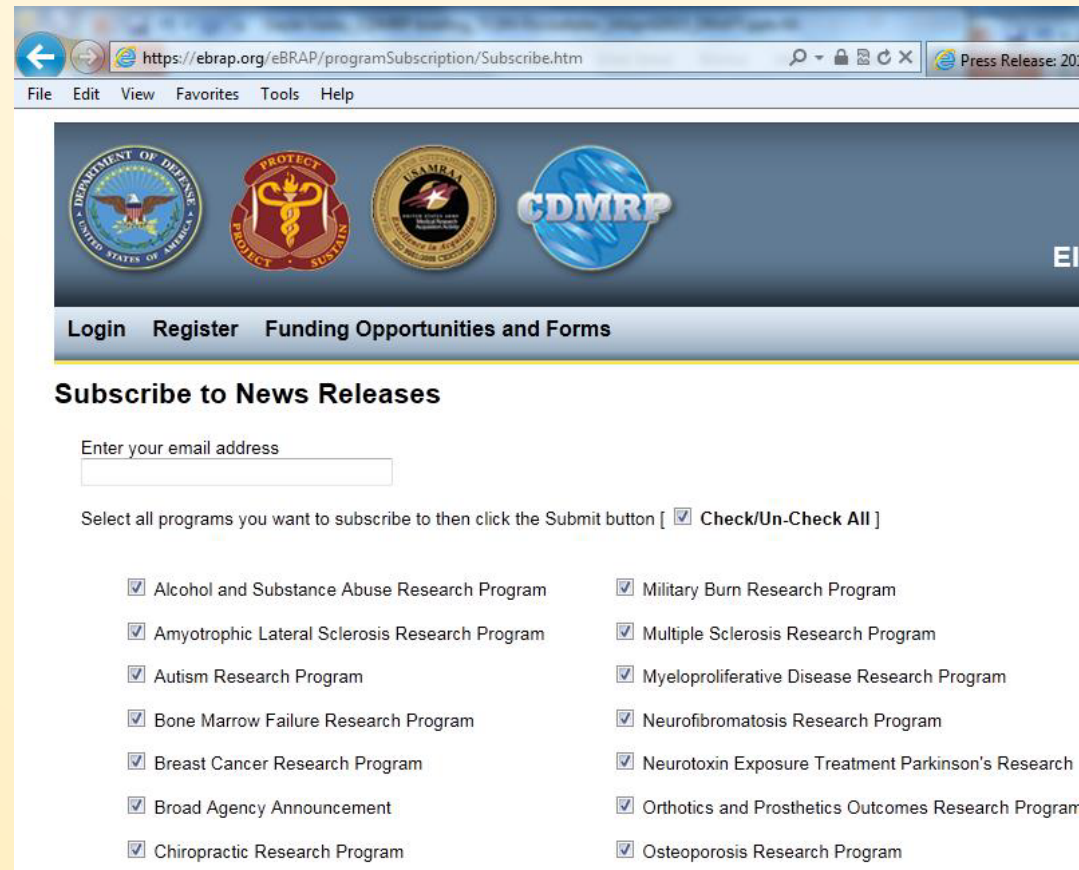

- System-to-System using Coeus

STEP 3: Post-Submission Management

- Submissions are managed in eBRAP until Peer-Review
- Review – Make Changes - Certify

- The pre-application is mandatory and must be received by the deadline

- Select Dorothy J. Harrison as the Business Official
- The PI submits the pre-application, no Coeus record is needed
- Email notification of submission will be sent to the contacts listed on the pre-application
- Full proposal invitation status will be posted in eBRAP
- Each pre-application is assigned a unique Pre-Application Log Number (Proposal ID) by the eBRAP system.

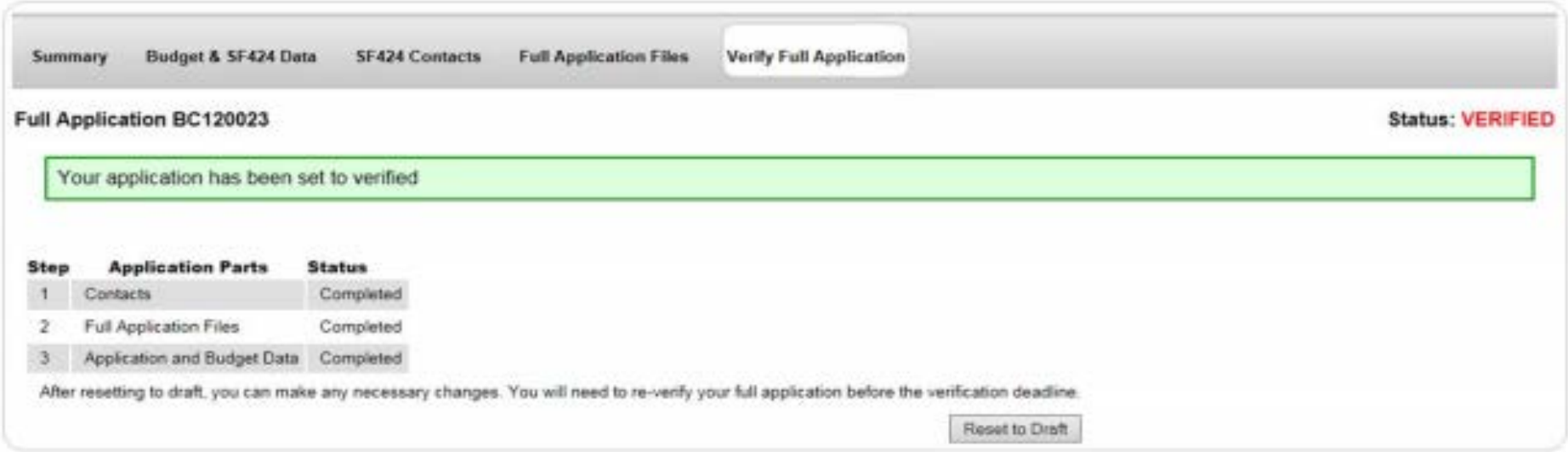
