Vanderbilt-wide Limited Submission Opportunity 2025 Mallinckrodt Grant Program

Applications due May 9, 2025

Vanderbilt (VU + VUMC): This is a joint competition for VU and VUMC investigators. All investigators should follow these instructions.

Vanderbilt (VU and VUMC, collaboratively) may submit **one proposal** for the <u>Edward Mallinckrodt</u>, <u>Jr</u>. <u>Foundation Grant Program</u>. The Foundation supports early-stage investigators engaged in basic biomedical research that has the potential to significantly advance the understanding, diagnosis, or treatment of disease. The grant provides \$75,000/year for up to a total of **\$225,000** over three years to move a project forward to the point where R01 or other independent funding can be obtained. Indirect costs are not allowable, but salary support is acceptable. View the <u>application guidelines</u> for more information.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following on August 1, 2025:

- Hold M.D. and/or Ph.D. degree
- Be in first to fourth year of a tenure-track position
- Must not have current R01 funding

Internal Application Process:

Anyone interested in being considered as Vanderbilt's potential nominee must submit the following (in a single PDF) to <u>LSO@vanderbilt.edu</u> by <u>5:00 p.m. on May 9, 2025</u>.

- 1. Brief research plan including summary budget (2 page maximum);
- Lay summary (1/2 page maximum);
- 3. Letter of support from department chair/center director;
 - a. Letter must acknowledge that this grant does not allow indirect costs.** This statement can be used/modified within the letter: "The Department recognizes that this grant does not allow indirect costs and will commit to covering any associated indirect costs per applicable institutional policy."
- 4. NIH Biosketch (5 page maximum)
