Among many highlights is a visit to the long-awaited Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM). Be one of the earliest visitors to the largest archaeological museum in the world dedicated to a single civilization.

Not far from the GEM, Vanderbilt travelers will have the exclusive chance to go "mano-a-mano" with the Sphinx with behind-the-scenes access to the Sphinx Paws. This puts you face to face with the famous Dream Stela of Pharoah Thutmosis IV, telling the story of the king as a young boy falling asleep in the shadow of the Sphinx. Additionally, see the new Royal Mummies Hall at the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. Also featured is a private visit to Queen Nefertari's Tomb, considered to be the most beautiful of all Pharaonic tombs. Nefertari was Ramses II's favorite wife, and he ordered this tomb built to guarantee her eternal status.

The hotels selected for this program are extraordinary. Starting with the Four Seasons Nile Plaza on the banks of the Nile in Cairo, to the famous Sofitel Old Winter Palace in Luxor, and the incredible Sofitel Legend Old Cataract Hotel in Aswan built by the British in 1902. All exude an elegance and historical significance to enrich your experience.

This itinerary has been specially designed for Vanderbilt alumni to include the country's most iconic treasures as well as unusual and unique points of interest often overlooked by other programs. In Cairo, along with your special day of Pyramids & Sphinx touring in Giza, visit King Djoser's famous Step Pyramid at Sakkara and see select Old Kingdom Tombs. Stroll along famed El Moaz Street in the Khan el Khalili Bazaar in Islamic Cairo, past a cascade of stunning Islamic architecture. Take a leisurely three-night Nile cruise on the 5-star M/S Farah between Aswan & Luxor.

Enhance this program with a Prelude to Jordan featuring the long-lost, rose-colored city of Petra, and/or a Postlude to the Sahara's legendary Siwa Oasis, visited by Alexander the Great in 332 BCE when he searched for the Temple of Amun to be declared a God.

Tour Karnak Temple with its massive hypostyle hall consisting of 134 columns. Continue to Luxor Temple with its famous Avenue of the Sphinxes. (B,L,D)

### **SOFITEL OLD WINTER PALACE**

Travel to the West Bank of ancient Thebes to explore the Valley of the Kings and the tombs of King Tutankhamon, Seti I and Ramses VI. Marvel at the colorful columns at Medinat Habu Temple and see the giant Colossi of Memnon. (B)


