Marshall C. Eakin is a historian of Latin America specializing in the history of modern Brazil. He joined the Vanderbilt History Department 1983 and retired in 2024. His research has concentrated on economic and business history, industrialization, and the processes of nationalism and nation-building—primarily in the twentieth century. He has been the recipient of the **Jeffrey Nordhaus Award for Excellence** in Undergraduate Teaching, the **Chancellor’s Cup**, the **Madison Sarratt Prize for Excellence** in Undergraduate Teaching, and the **Alumni Education Award**. He has lectured on eleven alumni trips from Patagonia to the Caribbean. His next book, *The Shattered Mirror: Richard Francis Burton in Nineteenth Century Brazil*, should appear in late 2025.
