From the rice terraces cascading down the hillsides, lush in greens before found only in imagination, to the startling flash of a parrot wing. - Ubud is a thriving village in central Bali that is considered the cultural capital of this tiny island. Famous as an arts and crafts hub, much of Ubud and nearby areas consist of artists' workshops and galleries. Here you find remarkable architecture as well as historical museums, artists and an array of interesting cafes, local foods and non-stop ceremonies. The word Ubud comes from the Balinese word for medicine, so it is here that people flock for healing energies, good spirits, meditation, yoga, artistry and indigenous knowledge.
- Pemuteran is a small fishing village on the northwest coast of Bali. Known for having the largest area of shallow coral reefs in Bali, it is home to the largest artificial coral reef project in the world. The village is a model of community-based tourism and conservation and has been recognized by the United Nations.
- Sanur is a seaside town in southeastern Bali. A long stretch of beach with calm, shallow waters and colorful jukung fishing boats resting on the sand complete the blissful ambiance. Great restaurants, a wide variety of shops and relaxed atmosphere make it the perfect spot to pick-up last minute gifts or lounge by the beach or pool.

Gather around the table for fine meals of the delectable Balinese cuisine drawn from the sea, the land and the rainforest. An exclusive Welcome Dinner, exquisite evening at Blahbatuh Palace with members of the Royal Family and Balinese Legong dance performance, and Farewell Dinner on the beach are among your included meals, all steeped in the local flavors and spices of this island paradise.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 10 & SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11: DEPART USA

EN ROUTE

Depart on your international overnight flight(s) to Denpasar, Bali (flights not included, can be arranged by DAI)

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 12: ARRIVE DENPASAR, BALI / UBUD

KAMANDALU RESORT

Upon arrival in Denpasar, meet, greet and transfer to your luxurious 5-star hotel in Ubud, Tonight a Welcome Dinner entices with a taste of Balinese cuisine. (D)

MONDAY, OCTOBER 13: UBUD

KAMANDALU RESORT

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 15: UBUD

Visit a local balian, or traditional Balinese healer, to learn about herbal treatments and massage. Meet I Wayan Muka, a third generation, world-renowned mask maker from Mas village. He produces traditional masks for Balinese theater and is himself a skilled dancer. (B,L)

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 16: UBUD

KAMANDALU RESORT

Today go to the famous rice paddies of Ubud to learn more about Subak, a Balinese life philosophy in action that also has a UNESCO World Heritage designation. This afternoon engage with women and children of the local community focusing on yoga and gardening. A special dinner is catered by the PKP Women's Center and their amazing cooking skills. (B,D)

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17: UBUD / PEMUTERAN

TAMAN SARI RESORT & SPA

Transfer to Pemuteran, a small fishing village on the northwestern coast of Bali. It lies between the gorgeous mountainous region to the south and Menjangan Island in the north. Shallow coral reefs grace the area, making it spectacular diving and snorkeling site. This evening watch a dazzling sunset aboard traditional fishing boats known as jukungs. (B,L)

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18: PEMUTERAN

TAMAN SARI RESORT & SPA

Experience firsthand an amazing initiative using technology to speed the growth of coral reefs. Visit a turtle hatchery working to increase the number of sea turtles in waters around Bali. This evening you are invited into the home of a Balinese family for a special dinner. Return to your hotel via Melanting Temple, Bali's temple for prosperity. (B,D)

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 19: PEMUTERAN

TAMAN SARI RESORT & SPA

Spend the day on Menjangan Island, home to one of the world's most biodiverse array of coral reefs and marine life in the world. Lunch on the island. (B,L)
