## Distinguished Lecture on Climate Change Governance

The Energy, Environment & Land Use Program will welcome Dr. James Marshall Shepherd on September 9 to deliver the third annual Distinguished Lecture on Climate Change Governance, made possible by the Sally Shallenberger Brown EELU Program Fund.

## Dr. J. Marshall Shepherd

Dr. Shepherd, a meterologist whose research focuses on the intersection of atmospheric sciences and society, is the Georgia Athletic Association Distinguished Professor and the Director of the Atmospheric Sciences Program at the University of Georgia. Prior to UGA, Shepherd spent 12 years as a Research Meteorologist at NASA-Goddard Space Flight Center and was Deputy Project Scientist for the Global Precipitation Measurement mission, a multi-national space mission that launched in 2014. In 2004, President George W. Bush presented him with the Presidential Early Career Award for pioneering scientific research in weather and climate science. And in 2021, he was elected to the National Academy of Sciences, National Academy of Engineering, and American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He is a past chair of the NASA Earth Sciences Advisory Committee, and former President of the American Meteorological Society. Among his many accomplishments, Shepherd is the host of The Weather Channel's Award-Winning show 'Weather Geeks,' and he is also a senior contributor to Forbes, writing columns on weather and climate, and commenting on the scientific enterprise.
