

## Respondus LockDown Browser Instructor Guide

This guide describes how to enable a test for the use of the Respondus Lockdown Browser. Best practices are also included.

In order to enable the Respondus Lockdown Browser for a test, you must first have a test created and deployed in your course.

1. You'll first need to make the Respondus tool available in your course. Go to the **Control Panel, Customization, Tool Availability**.


2. On the next page, scroll down and find Respond Lockdown Browser, select the **checkbox** next to its name, then click **submit**.

4. On the next page, click the icon next to the test name and choose **modify settings**.

**Using a password (optional)** - Use of a password prevents someone outside of the classroom from going on-line in their own room with text and notes at the same time others are taking the exam in class. Using a password and then posting the password in the test room at the beginning of the class is a good idea.

## Best practices for the use and implementation of Respondus Lockdown Browser in your Blackboard course:

1. When students are taking tests outside of the classroom such as at home or in another<br/>unmonitored space, they can use a second computer or a mobile device to conduct internet searches<br/>or take pictures of the testing screen, thus rendering the LockDown browser less effective.D0 use to provide an extra layer of<br/>security in monitored testsD0N'T use in unmonitored situations2. This tool should be used in conjunction with the<br/>untegrity and trust between students and faculty.University's honor code to encourage academic<br/>of suspicion in the classroomD0 talk about academic integrity and the<br/>Honor Code with your studentsD0N'T allow the tool to create a culture<br/>of suspicion in the classroom

<b>3.</b> The LockDown browser can interact in unexpected ways with students' various operating			
systems, ad-blockers, and malware detection software. Make sure students are aware of the potential			
problems and have practiced with the browser beforehand to ensure they will be able to use the
