

Eastman Masters in Finance (MSF) Diversity Scholarship

The Eastman Masters of Finance (MSF) Diversity Scholarship is available for underrepresented minority and female students who have demonstrated enthusiasm and a natural aptitude in finance and leadership. For this scholarship, Eastman is seeking candidates who can lead successfully through exciting and motivating others.

Eligibility Requirements:

Admitted into full time enrollment in the Masters of Finance program at Vanderbilt University

Complete the application by June 15, 2019.

Maintain a 3.0 GPA upon graduation

Employment requirement- the scholarship recipient understands that if selected and accepts the scholarship, that they are making a commitment to work at Eastman for 2 years (24 months). If employment is terminated by the scholarship recipient prior to 24 months from my report to work date of employment, the scholarship recipient shall be obligated to repay the scholarship on a prorated basis acceptable to Eastman.

Selection Process:

Student will need to submit application along with a resume by June 15, 2019.

Selected students will interview with Eastman's Finance organization for Masters level finance roles. There is a potential of a site interview in Kingsport, TN.

Selected student must be eligible to work in the US without sponsorship both now and in the future

All students will be notified of determination at the end of the selection process

Benefits of the Scholarship

\$30K grossed up scholarship to reimburse the recipient for out of pocket tuition paid once employment at Eastman begins.

The scholarship recipient will be provided with an Eastman Finance mentor while attending the Vanderbilt MSF program

Guaranteed full time position at Eastman after graduation.

Relocation benefits provided with the move to the Corporate Office once the scholarship recipient begins the full-time position.
