For individually created interdisciplinary majors, which must include a minimum of 48 hours, this form must be accompanied by a written proposal outlining the rationale for the major.

Students may combine an interdisciplinary major with a departmental major. Normally no more than three introductory-level courses will be counted toward the interdisciplinary major or a maximum of 6 hours may be applied to another major. Students intending to complete a minor should be aware that a minor must include at least 15 hours that are not being counted toward the major.
