This contract must include from 36-48 hours of course work. After approval from the faculty adviser and the Committee on Individual Programs, it is deemed to be a statement of required courses. Any subsequent changes in the contract must be made in writing, in advance of the beginning of the student's graduating semester, and approved by the faculty adviser and the Dean. For individually created interdisciplinary majors, which must include a minimum of 48 hours, this form must be accompanied by a written proposal outlining the rationale for the major.

Students may combine an interdisciplinary major with a departmental major. Normally no more than three introductory-level courses will be counted toward the interdisciplinary major or a maximum of 6 hours may be applied to another major. Students intending to complete a minor should be aware that a minor must include at least 15 hours that are not being counted toward the major.
