BRIEF OVERVIEW

Research

Dr. Gonzales has published more than 80 peer-reviewed studies in high impact social science, public health, and medical journals. His research on LGBTQ+ health, health policy, and population health has been funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH) and the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF). Dr. Gonzales' research has been cited more than 3,000 times since 2020, including citations in reports released by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine (NASEM). In 2016, Dr. Gonzales was awarded the inaugural Chancellor's Award for Research on Equity, Diversity and Inclusion at Vanderbilt University for his research on LGBTQ+ health. He was promoted to Associate Professor (with tenure) in 2023.

Teaching

Dr. Gonzales teaches courses in health policy, quantitative research methods, and LGBTQ+ health for undergraduate students at Vanderbilt University. He also mentors undergraduate, graduate, and medical students interested in LGBTQ+ health equity research – and health disparities research, broadly. In 2024, he was awarded the Vanderbilt University Chancellor's Cup for "remarkable teaching and mentorship of undergraduate students."
