Instructions for mapping a drive to the EES server

PC Users – Computers that don't require VUNetID and connected via eathernet cable to the campus network:

- 1. Click on "My Computer" from Start menu.
- 2. Under the Tools menu choose "Map Network Drive".
- 3. In the Drive box, choose a drive letter, for example "H" for home drive.
- 4. In the Folder box type choose one of the following: <u>\\ees\users\VUNetID</u> (your VUNetID) <u>\\ees\research</u>
- \\ees\courses
- 5. Uncheck "Reconnect at logon"
- 6. Check "Connect Using a Different Credentials/Username".
- 7. In the first box type vanderbilt\VUNetID (your VUNetID)
- 8. In the second box type your VUNetID Password.
- 9. Click "OK", the folder will automatically open and can be seen as a Network Location in "My Computer"

Mac Users Using OS X: *

- 1. Under the Go menu select Connect to Server.
- 2. Address: smb://10.8.132.52.
- 3. Click Connect.
- 4. Login with your VUNetID and Password.
- 5. Select the folder you would like to view.
- 6. Network folder can be found under "Computer"

Connecting off-campus:

If you are attempting to connect off-campus, you will need to log in through VU-IT VPN for remote access:
