An AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) is located in Calhoun Hall in the front hallway opposite the front door.

In addition, all Vanderbilt Police Department officers have AEDs in all their vehicles. In the event of any emergency call 911 from a campus phone or call 421-1911 from a cell phone.
