



**College Scholars Program
Proposal to Enrich a Course for an Honors Point**

College Scholars may earn one Honors point towards graduating with “Honors in the College of Arts & Science” by successfully completing an enrichment project in a course in which they are enrolled. The enrichment project should be roughly equivalent to one-third of the work expected for the course or equivalent to a one-hour research project, and is in addition to the academic work required for the course. No academic credit is granted for the enrichment project; an honors point is awarded instead of an hour credit. The work for this honors project should not be included in the determination of any grades for the course, but the student must earn a grade of B or better in the course and complete their project satisfactorily to earn the honors point. At the end of the semester, the instructor should inform the Director by email or short memo that the student’s project has been successfully completed, and that an honors point is recommended for the student’s work.

A one-page project proposal describing the nature of the enrichment project, the academic product(s) that will be created, and the due date(s) for these products must be included with this form. This form and the proposal must be submitted within four weeks of the beginning of the semester to Associate Dean Morgan, Director of the College Scholars Program.

Students and instructors will receive notification by email that the proposal has been approved. Please return this signed form and the one-page description of the project to 350 Buttrick Hall by the end of the 4th week of classes of the semester.
