## **Transitions**



### Questions:

- 1. How do I prepare students to move from one activity or setting to another?
- Transition cues: 10 minutes, 5 minutes, 3 minutes, 1 minute
- Use the lights, timers, songs, clapping to cue students that transitions are coming
- Check in with students to make sure directions are understood

# 2. How do I meet the individual needs of students who might need more support?

- Use visuals to support individual students such as First/Then chart
- Use photos of next activity so students know what to expect
- Use peers to help others transition
- Use native language or sign language to help with transition cues
- Teach the steps in a transition
- Check for understanding/student repeats transition steps

## 3. What do I do during transitions?

- Sing a song
- Use Mighty Minutes
- Map the classroom with my EA: I am at A(where the children are) My EA is at B(where I want my students to go) Roles among Teacher and EA may be reversed
- Give positive specific feedback to students who engage in transitions properly
- Begin next activity before all students have transitioned to reduce wait time
