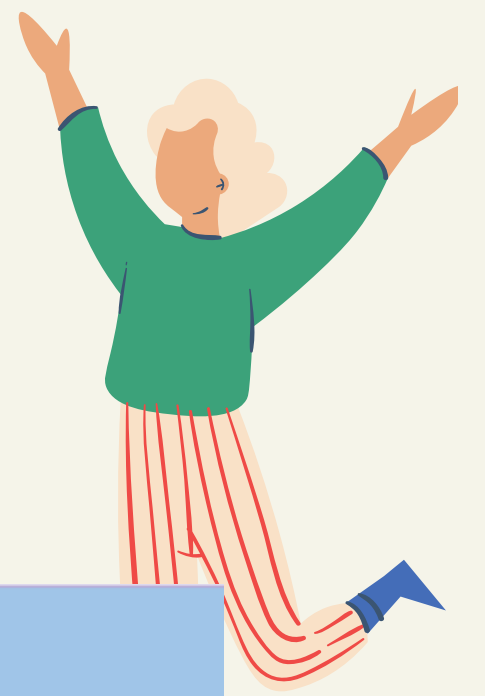

Action	Water Used
Toilet Flush	3 to 7 Gallons
Shower	25 to 50 Gallons
Hand Washing	2 Gallons (with tap running)
Brushing Teeth	2 Gallons (with tap running)
Outdoor Watering	5 to 10 Gallons per Minute
Automatic Dishwashing	10 Gallons
Dishwashing By Hand	20 Gallons
Tub Bath	36 Gallons
