The historic Union Baptist Church of Baltimore, Maryland is prayerfully seeking a full-time senior pastor.

Organized in 1852 from a North Street location, our current sanctuary, dedicated in 1905, is the first church in Baltimore City built "by Negroes for Negroes" and was listed on the US National Register of Historical Places in 2010. In its 171 years of existence, Union Baptist Church has consistently had a rich history of pastoral leadership, evangelism, and community involvement.

The candidate must be a born again, baptized believer in Jesus Christ, who loves God and His people and adheres to the Biblical doctrine in 1Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:6-9.

Additionally, the ideal candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Be an ordained minister,
- Have a minimum of 3 years of preaching experience,
- Possess an earned master's degree in theology/divinity or a related field,
- Be knowledgeable in church administration,
- Be committed to faithfully preach the Word of God,
- Exhibit excellent verbal, written and computer communication skills,
- Exhibit ability to collaborate with lay leaders and members of the congregation,
- Demonstrate a willingness to promote and encourage quality improvement in all segments of the church's ministries and operations,
- In all ways maintain a commitment to Christian education; and
- Pass an official background check.
