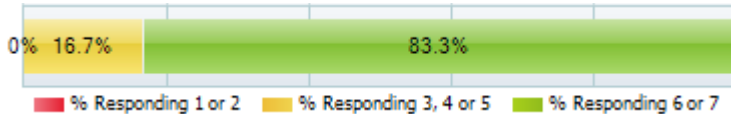

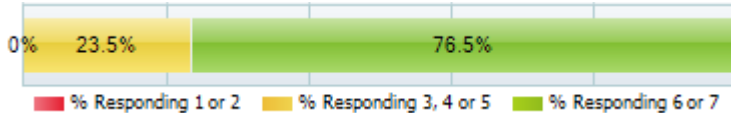

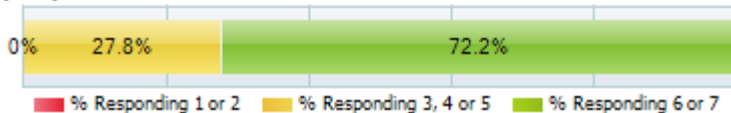

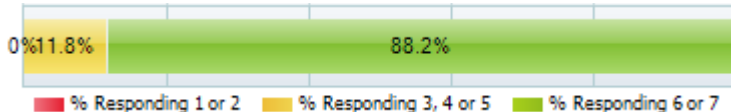

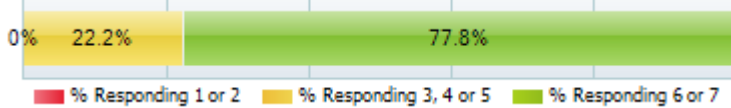

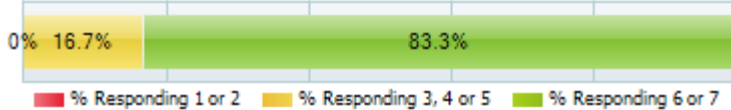

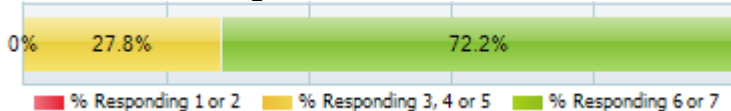

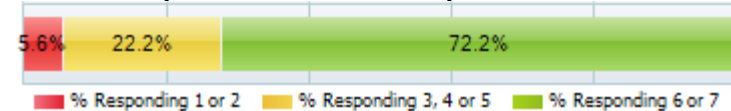

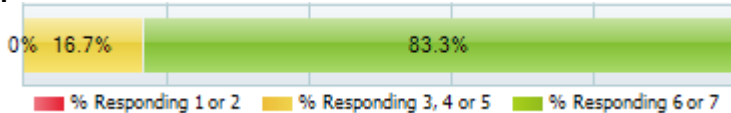

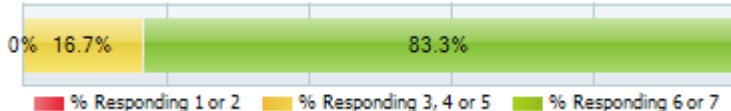

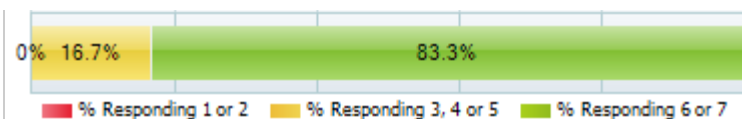

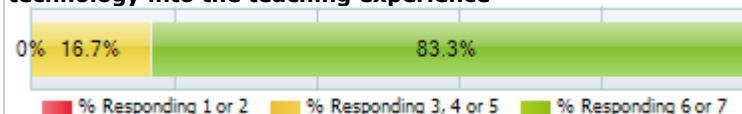

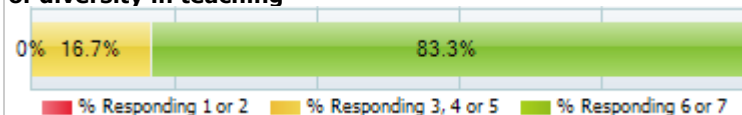

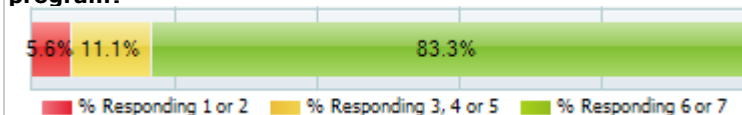

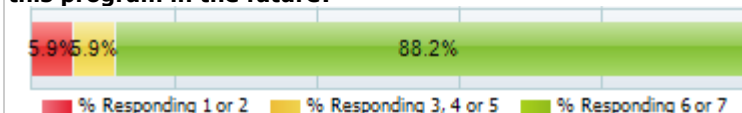
**Q018. Overall Evaluation - To what degree: Are you satisfied with the overall performance of recent graduates from this program?**

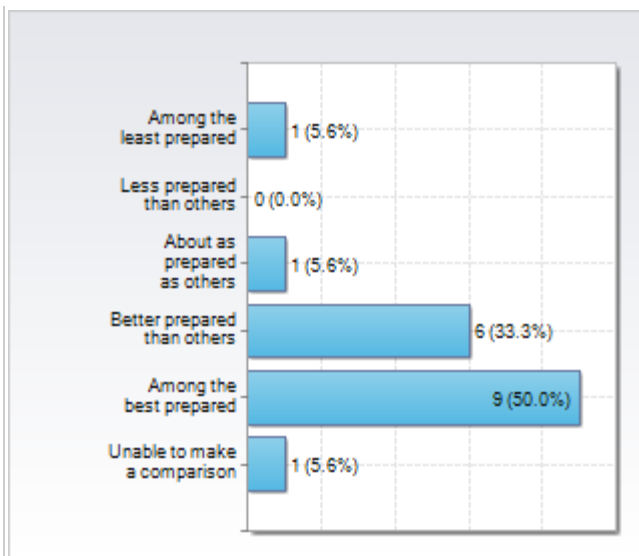

##### Answer

I've found that the student-teaching experience seems limited to MNPS magnet schools. This could just be my limited experience with students from the program, but I have hired 3 and they all have similar experiences.

Ms. Tetreault served Shwab well. She is an asset to the profession!

Hard to say. She is fantastic.

The one thing I see student teachers/first year teachers struggle with the most is classroom management. They have a good sense of relationship building which is huge but seem unsure about supports for struggling students or a firm grasp on setting up routines and structures for proactive approaches.

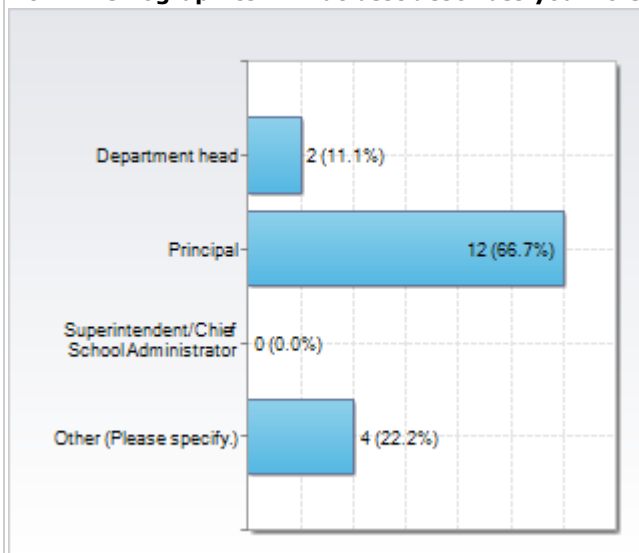
The graduates come prepared to work in our early childhood classrooms. I just wish more of them stuck around the area after graduation. This year, I had only one applicant that was a practicum teacher.

Guide them in professional courtesy. For example, when resigning the position, meet with the Principal in person or phone. Many recent graduates email with the news.

As you are aware the public education system is grappling with real, basic, hopefully transformative challenges. It is too easy to be disillusioned and impatient as a novice teacher. I suggest revisiting how you empower your students to be change agents within the public school system not just in a theoretical, policy or research world. Our students need your people as change agents in the classrooms.

We might have found a one-off. I have heard good things about Vanderbilt's special education program but the person that we had (Emerson Morris) had no idea about the time commitment and work ethic needed to be a teacher. He engaged in many conversations with staff, students and families that were unprofessional and was unable to maintain his composure during any times of conflict. I am shocked that he was endorsed by your program.

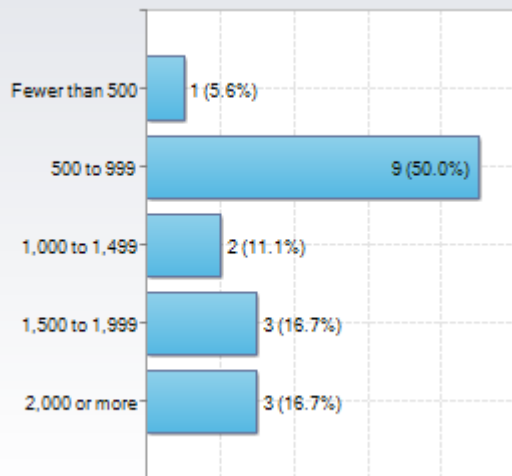

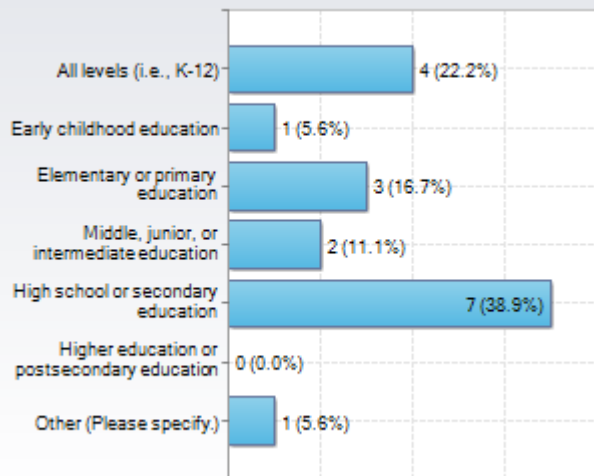
