## ■ Institutional & Local Organizations

**Center for Spiritual and Religious Life:** nurtures an inclusive community of communities consisting of diverse religious, spiritual, and secular perspectives, wisdom traditions, and worldviews where all Vanderbilt students, faculty, postdoctoral scholars, and staff are invited to experience hospitality, to engage in discovery, and to practice generosity.

**Peabody Jewish Association:** student organization for Peabody professional and graduate students interested in Jewish-related programming striving to enhance Peabody's diversity awareness, serving as a Jewish-themed social and educational resource.

## ■ National Organizations

**American Academy of Religion:** members can search employment listings in relevant disciplines through a job board, managed jointly with the Society of Biblical Literature.

**Association for Biblical Higher Education:** enhances the quality and credibility of postsecondary educational institutions that distinctively engage students in biblical, transformational, experiential, and missional higher education.

**Association for Jewish Studies:** Career Center jobs board has comprehensive listings of current open positions and post-doctoral fellowships in the field.

**Christian Career Center:** resource featuring a job board, career guidance and job search resources, and Christian career coaching.

**Hindu American Foundation:** educational and advocacy organization offering a Human Rights Fellowship for graduate students interested in human rights, international relations, and Hinduism generally.

**Islamic Networks Group:** a peace-building organization providing face-to-face education and engagement opportunities that foster understanding of Muslims and other misunderstood groups to promote harmony among all people.

**Muslim Advocates:** national civil rights organization that litigates, educates, and advocates for the equal treatment of American Muslims to free from discrimination.

**Muslim Americans in Public Service:** supports the career, workplace, and community development of Muslim American public servants and serves as a catalyst, resource, and force multiplier for the associations that represent and support them.

**Teaching While Muslim:** support group and network for Muslim educators that addresses biases, intersectionality, and social justice through professional development services.

**U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission:** federal guidance and resources regarding illegal pre-employment inquiries and religious affiliation or beliefs.
