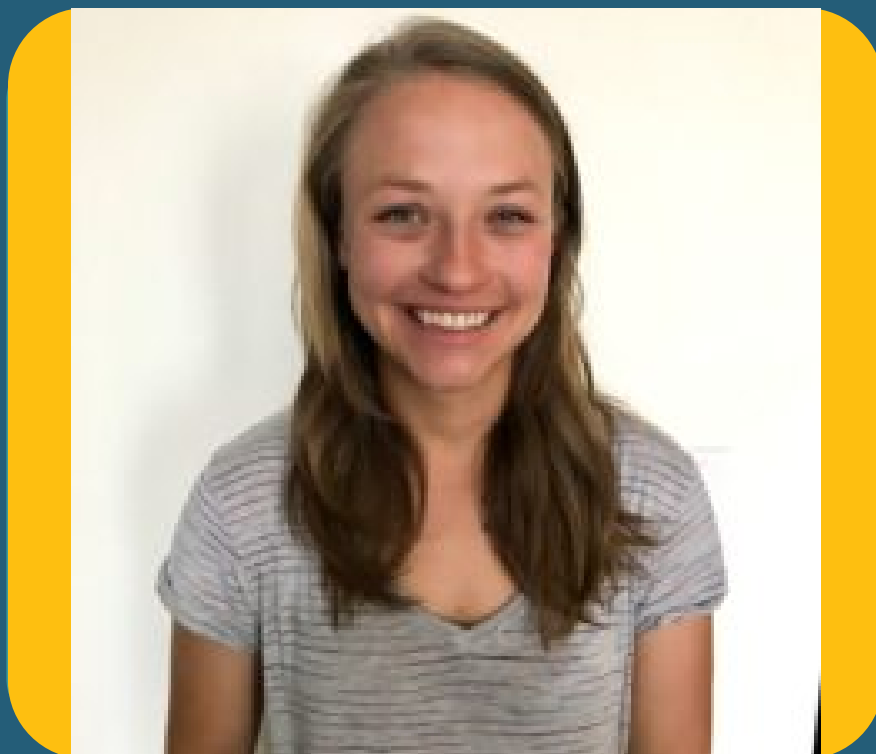

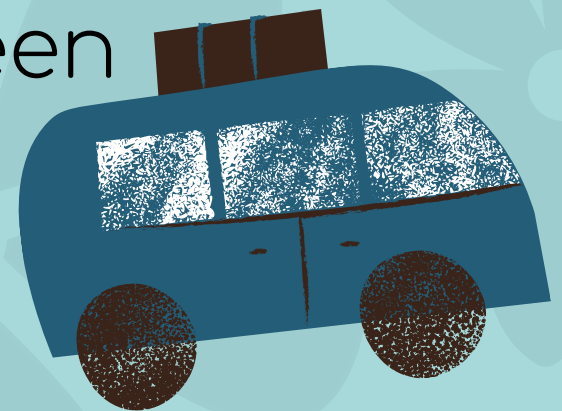

We've shown improvements in parent use of effective intervention strategies and reductions in child challenging behavior as a result of app use at home. I love this project because it hits two of my favorite bases - supporting parents at home and improving outcomes for children. I've also done some work on the use of antecedent physical activity as an intervention strategy for preschoolers with challenging behavior."
