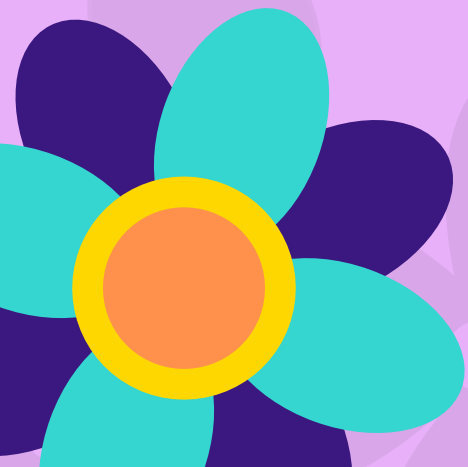

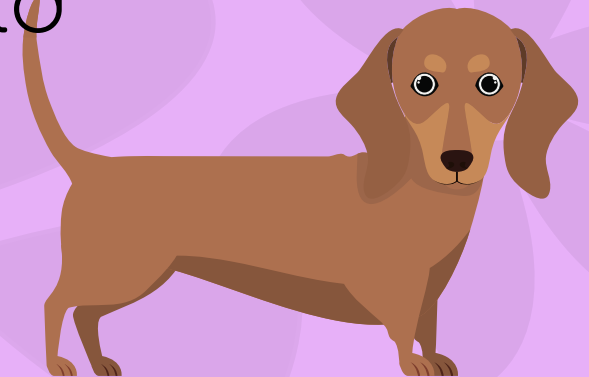

fitness and dancing!

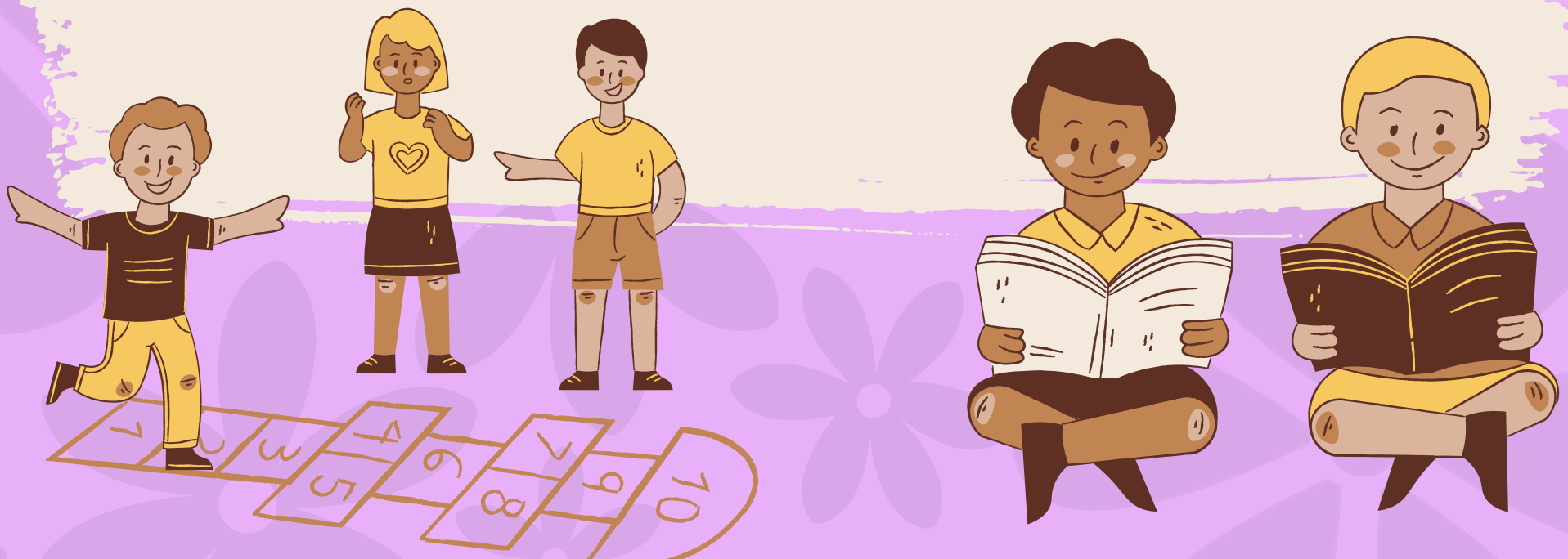
