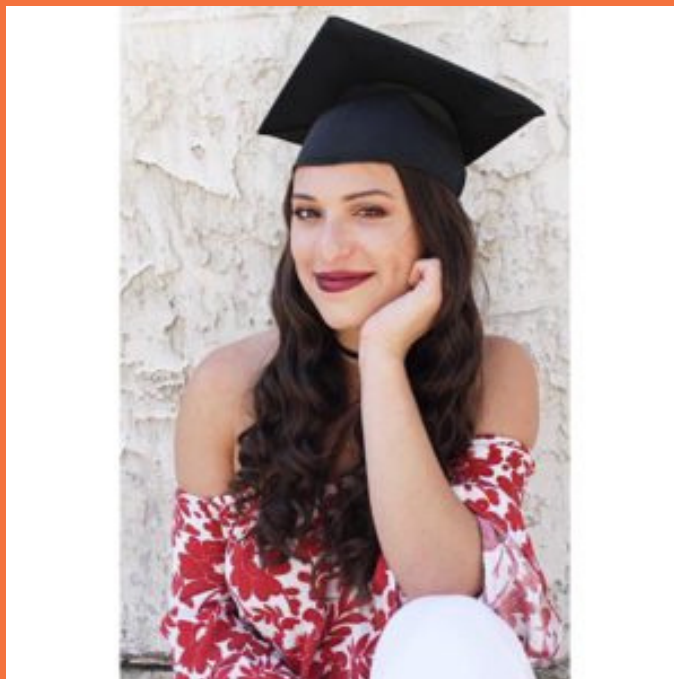

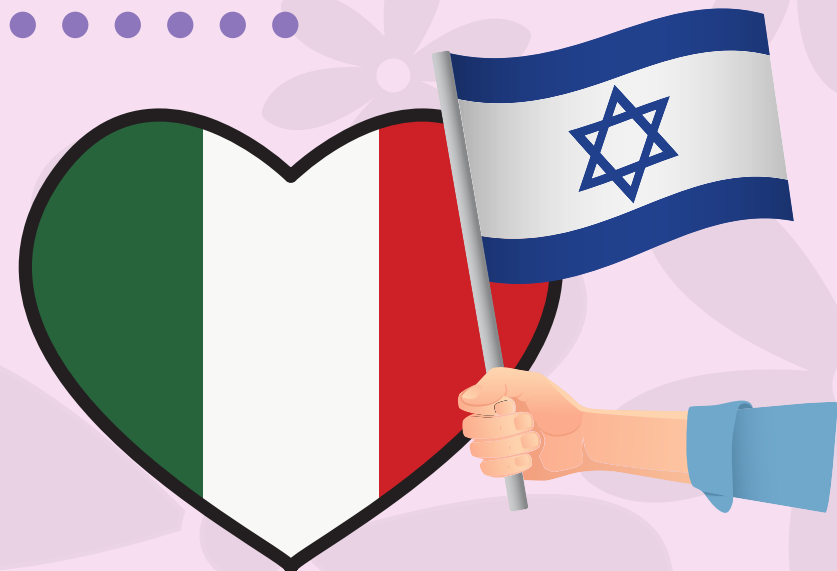
# THE BARTON BUNCH

The ways we can effectively train parents to use strategies that reduce their child's challenging behavior (e.g., aggression, self-injury)



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## CAROLINE BAUM, B.A.

What have you been researching in Barton Lab?

"I have enjoyed working on the Family Behavior Support App and measuring the efficacy of coaching a family to use the app for my master's thesis. We found that coaching the parent to use the app across four routines increased the parent's use of PTR (prevent challenging behavior, teach new skills, and new responses to challenging behavior) strategies and decreased child challenging behavior."

What do you hope to do after you graduate from Vanderbilt?

"I would love to coach parents and families of culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds on strategies for decreasing child challenging behavior within the home."
