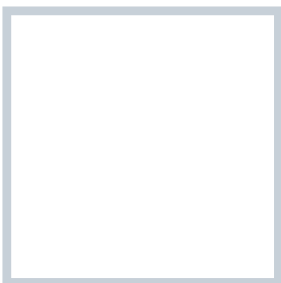
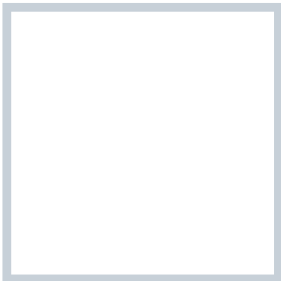
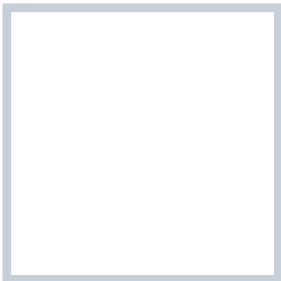
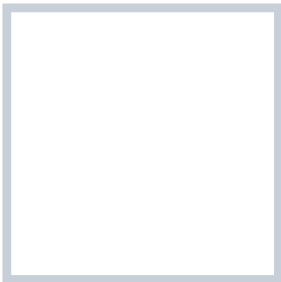
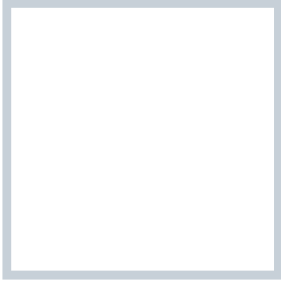
**As your child completes each activity or routine, remove the image from the schedule and place it in an envelope or ziploc bag labeled "All Done."**

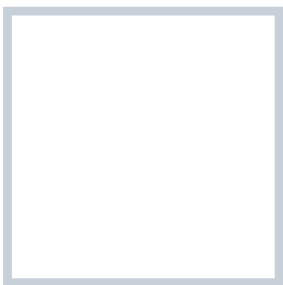
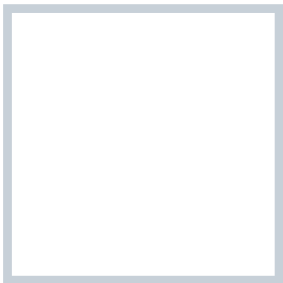
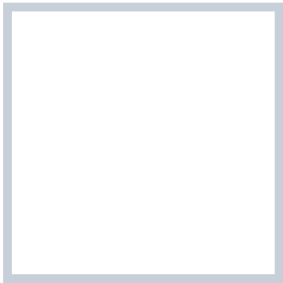
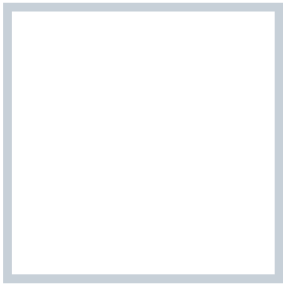
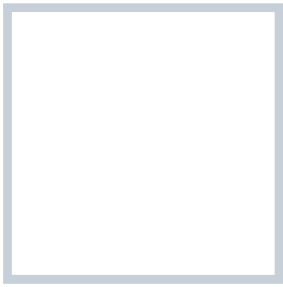
