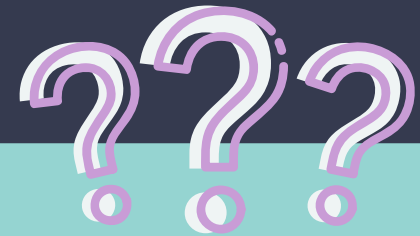

SET IT UP



Have children say their name and something about themselves (ex. what do you like to eat?).



"Hi, my name is Gabby and I like cheese and grapes."



Model for children how to start the sentence and support them if they are having trouble answering

SUPPORTING CONVERSATIONS

Support children in writing or drawing things about themselves.

Draw attention to what children like to point out similarities across students.

Encourage children to think of things they like about themselves and help them to draw or write.



CELEBRATE AND SHARE!



Display children's work to remind them of who they are and the similarities and differences they share with one another!

Share the idea with friends and coworkers and collaborate on different questions and topics to discuss with children!
