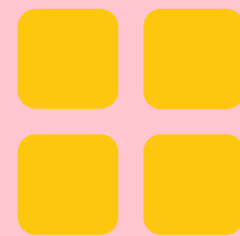


FUN FRIDAY FOUR CORNERS



Get children moving and foster social interactions with this fun game!



GET MOVING

Have the teacher start. They should close their eyes, count to 10 and tell children to pick a corner.

Call out a a number 1-4. Anyone in the corner you called must sit down.

Repeat until there is only one person left. This child is "it" and will call out the numbers the next time.



Variation: Instead, of numbers, label the corners as animals, colors, food, etc. Have child choose the corner with their favorite!

VIRTUAL LEARNING



Use jamboard on google! Put numbers 1-4 in each corner.



Have children create sticky notes with their names on it.

When you start the game, they can move their sticky to a corner of their choice!



The child with the last sticky note standing wins. Play again, and shake up the questions!

SUPPORT AND LEARN

Support children when they get called out of the game by validating their emotions and helping them to accept the loss

With this activity, children can play with one another, and get their bodies moving indoors

Cheer children on throughout the game!
