PRACTICE COLOR RECOGNITION USING THIS COLOR SORTING ACTIVITY

Setting It Up

Gather objects in a variety of colors (ex: pompom balls, blocks)



Gather containers to put objects in or mark off sections on the floor with tape

Label the container or section of the floor with a designated color



What To Do

Give children a few objects in a variety of different colors





Tell children to place the objects in the container or section that corresponds to the color of the object

Providing support: use <u>gestural</u> or <u>model prompts</u> to help children place the objects in the correct area

Variations

Divide children into teams and see who can sort their objects the fastest





Count the sorted objects to see which color has the most

Pair children to compare what they have together and share the number with the rest of the group
