HELPFUL SHORTCUTS TO ENHANCE YOUR ONLINE EXPERIENCE!

PURPOSE

With the transfer to online learning for many children, there is an increased reliance on technology for instruction and learning. However, using technology can be frustrating and confusing for children and caregivers. This infographic includes a few shortcuts that may reduce some of the stress that comes when you're learning a new device or application.



MAC USERS

Command-Shift-3: Take a screenshot

Command-F: Searches pages for specified word

you choose to type in

Command-C: Copies highlighted text

Command-V: Pastes previously copied text

Shift + Click Link: Opens link in new window





CHROMEBOOK USERS

Shift + Ctrl + q (twice): Sign out of

Google account

Ctrl + Show Windows: Take a screenshot

Press **Search** + **L:** Locks your screen

Ctrl + C: Copies highlighted text

Ctrl + V: Pastes previously highlighted text

GETTING THE MOSTOUT OF IPADS

When screen freezes: Press and hold lock button and home button until screen goes black. This forces the iPad to shut down! Press the power button to turn the iPad back on.

PDF

Scanning Documents: Locate the Notes app. Press the plus sign (+) button at the bottom. Press Scan Documents. Click Save and Voila! You now have a PDF of your document. No outside app necessary!

Quick Charge: Swipe down your drop down menu from the top right corner. Click the Airplane. This helps halt the background battery usage so you get the most out of your charge quickly!
