Celebrate Spring and the life cycle of a plant by reading your children "The Tiny Seed" by Eric Carle.



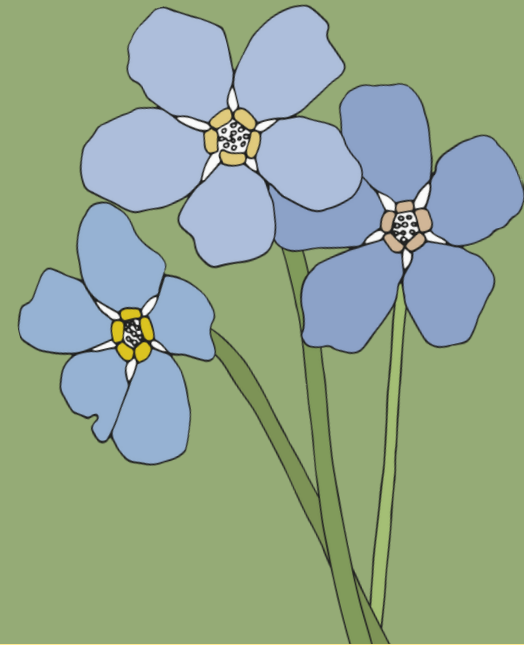
