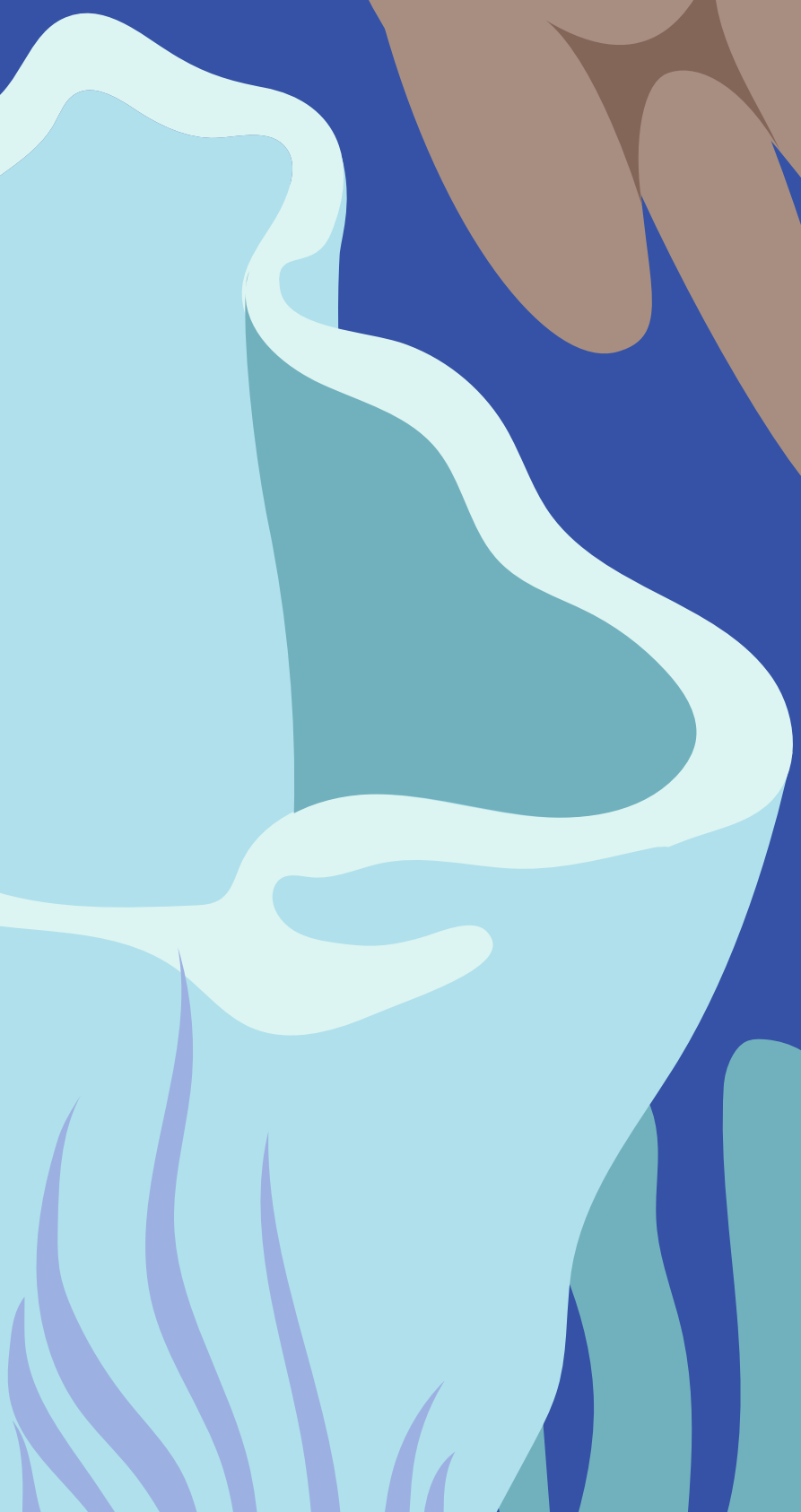
Otters eat kelp. Would you

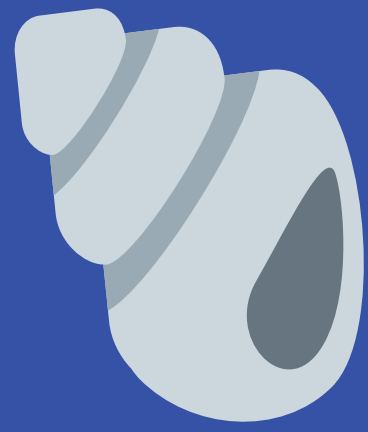
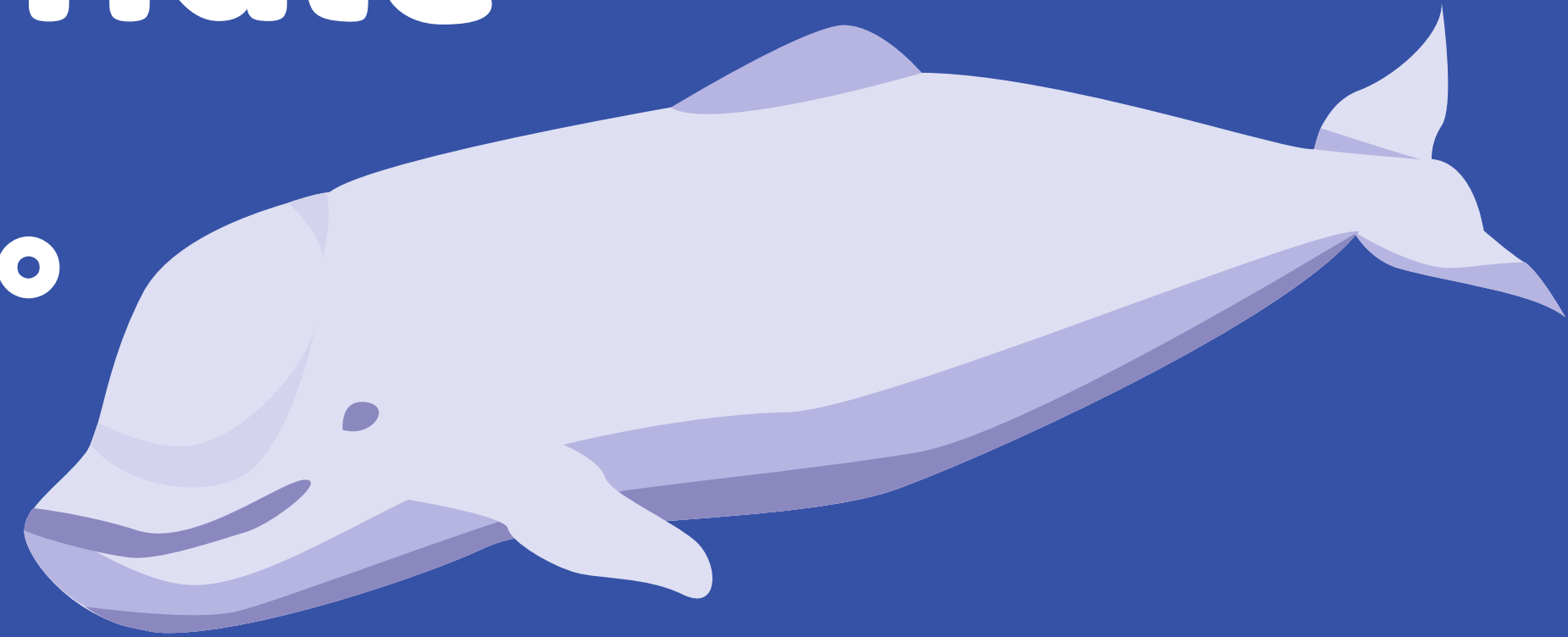

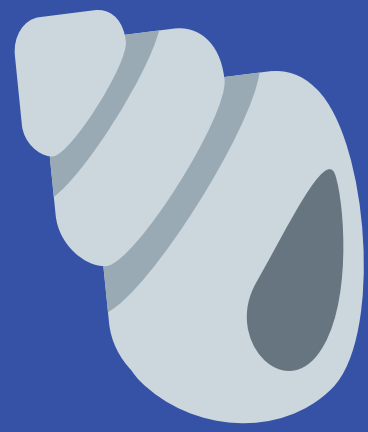

Beluga Whale



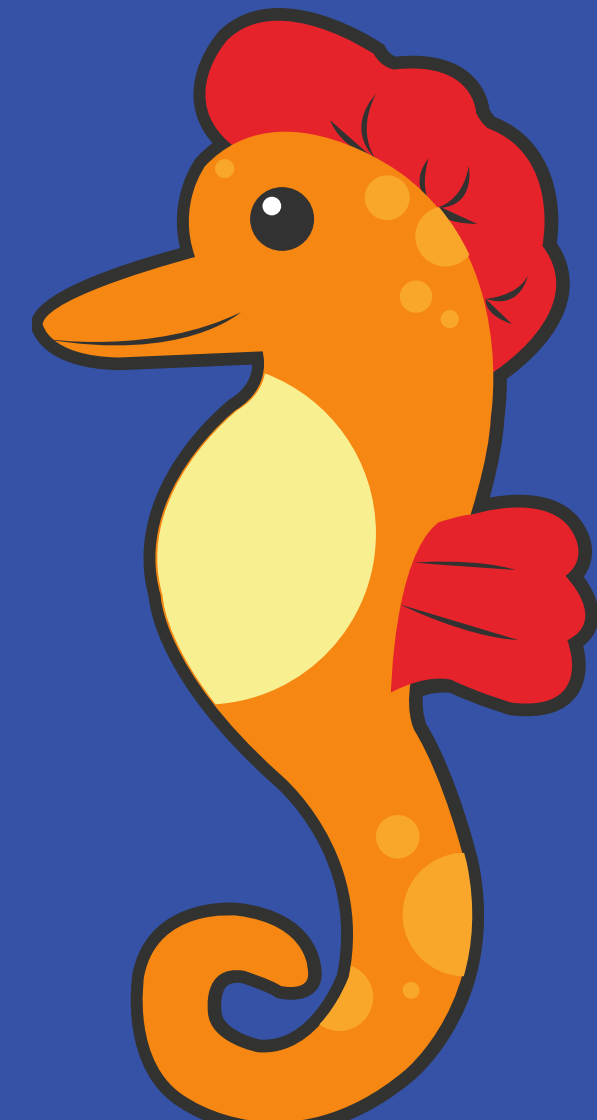
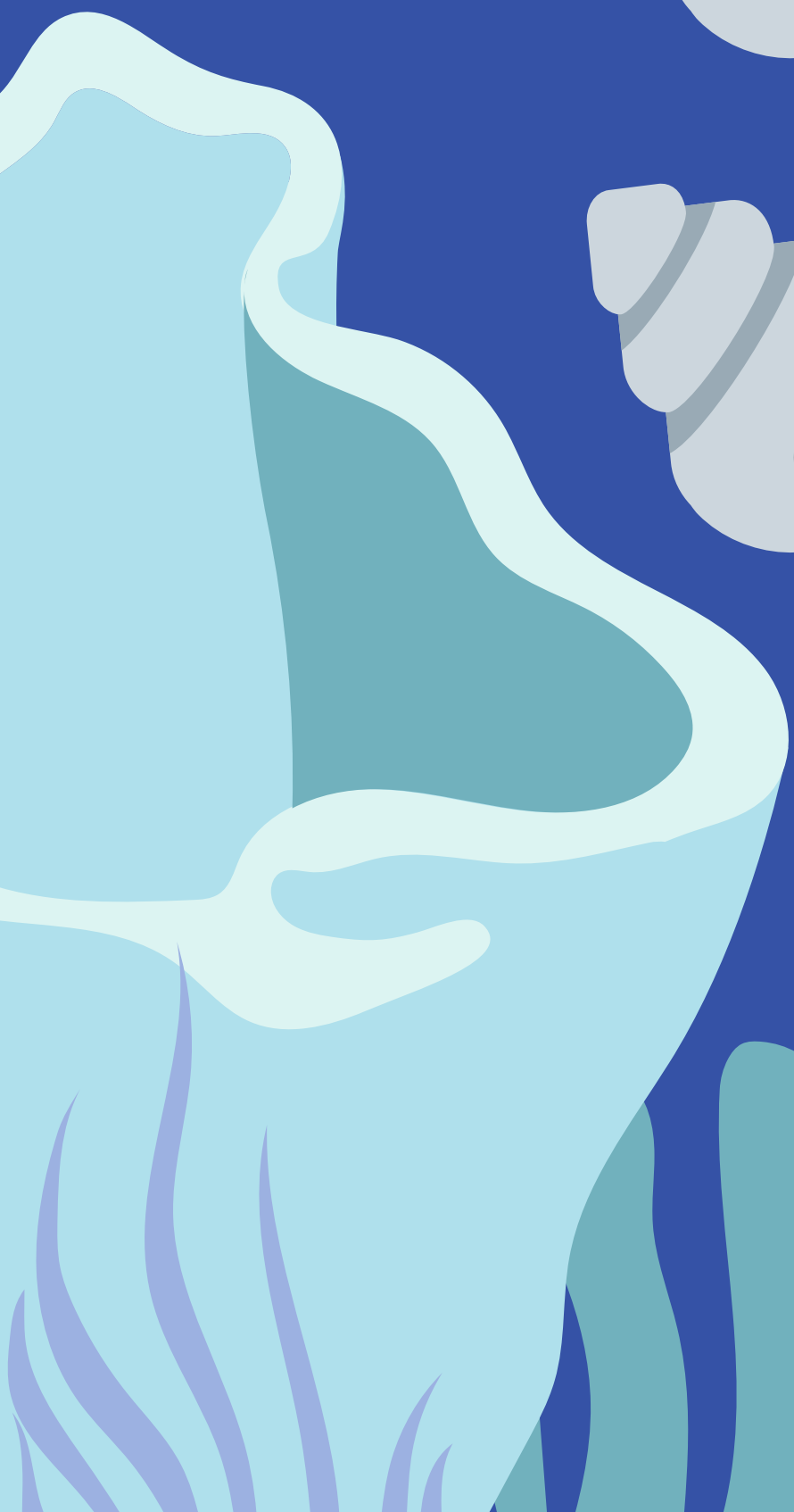
