

SET IT UP



Use this <u>print out</u> to cut out your favorite animals



Place an animal photo on each side of a die (or put into a bowl)



Have children roll the die or pull from a bowl



Have them label the animal and imitate what sound and movements the animal makes



Put on <u>music</u> to make the game more fun



Ask children what animals they want to add next time

Imitating animal movements can support gross and fine motor development (and is great exercise).
