MOVE IT MONDAY

PRACTICE:

Imitating adults and peers

Gross motor movements

Following multi-step directions (ex: jump three times then wiggle)

Video Vibes: Put on your favorite dance youtube video and dance like the person in the video

Show time: Come up with a dance to perform together

Dance battle: Take turns showing off your best moves and see if your can copy each other and add your own twist

PRACTICE:

Waiting for a turn

Telling you or a sibling to take a turn (ex: "Your turn" or point)

Charades: Have children take turns acting out animals/actions and have the others guess

Storytelling: Have each person say one word until you create a full story!

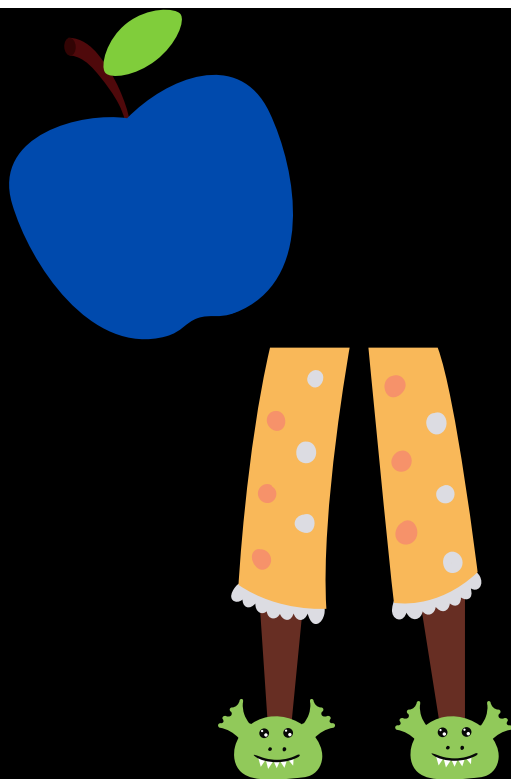
WACKY WEDNESDAY
