EXPLANATION OF FEES

Student Health Insurance fee

- This covers the cost of the Student Injury and Sickness Plan offered through Vanderbilt University.
- The term of coverage is 08/12/20-08/11/21 and additional details are provided by the <u>Student Health</u> <u>Center</u> (vumc.org/student-health).
- The annual fee is charged to the student's account in two installments: in the fall and spring terms.
- This fee may be waived for students who have coverage through a comparable plan. For more information, click here. Please note that the student must submit the online waiver form to gallagherstudent.com/vanderbilt no later than August 1, 2020.

Student Service Fees

- The fee is charged to the student's account each semester.

Transcript fee

- This covers lifetime access to electronic transcript and diploma requests from the <u>Office of the University Registrar</u> (registrar.vanderbilt.edu).
- The one-time fee is charged to first-time Vanderbilt students at the beginning of the fall term of the first year.
