Ph.D. Applicant Visit February, 4-5, 2019

The most promising Ph.D. applicants will be invited to visit campus on February 4-5, 2019. The two-day visit familiarizes applicants with the department and university resources. Applicants meet with individual faculty to learn about research training opportunities and interact with current Ph.D. students to hear their perspective on research training at Vanderbilt. Applicants will tour the Department of Hearing and Speech Sciences, the Vanderbilt campus and the Nashville community. Transportation to this meeting, housing and per diem is provided to invited applicants. Applicants will be contacted in early to mid-January to make travel arrangements.

The deadline for applications is January 15th.

The Ph.D. program emphasizes preparation for research and teaching careers in audiology, speech-language pathology, and hearing or speech science. Doctoral education and training is integrated with the federally-sponsored research programs of faculty members. Our department is committed to fully funding (tuition and stipend) accepted applicants for the period of Ph.D. training, typically 3 to 4 years.
