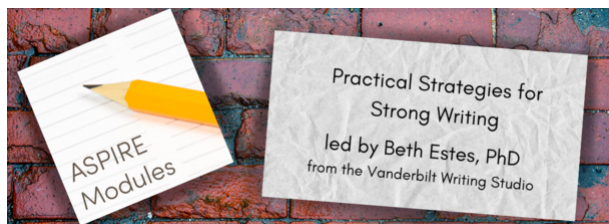
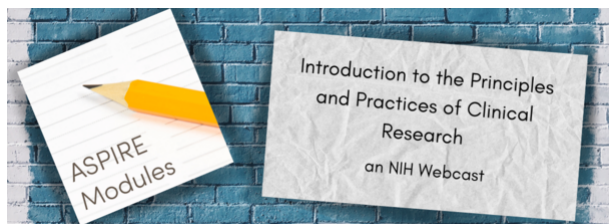
The fall ASPIRE Modules are back and this time

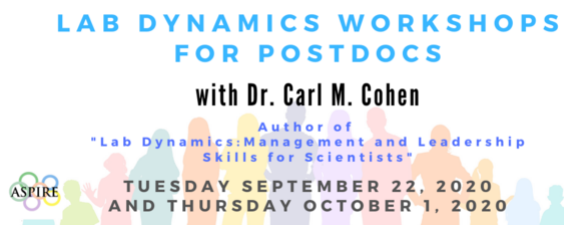
