

<u>ComSciCon</u> is a series of workshops focused on the communication of complex and technical concepts organized by graduate students, for graduate students. The Burroughs Wellcome Fund is now accepting applications for the **2021 Postdoctoral Enrichment Program**.

Offered by the California Council on Science and Technology (CCST), the <u>CCST Science and Technology Policy Fellowship</u> places professional scientists and engineers in the California State Legislature for one-year appointments. The program is designed to enable Fellows to work hands-on with policymakers in addressing complex scientific issues as well as assume all the other legislative responsibilities of full-time legislative staffers.

The Chateaubriand Fellowship is a grant offered by the Embassy of France in the United States. It supports outstanding PhD students from American universities who wish to conduct research in France for a period ranging from 4 to 9 months. Chateaubriand fellows are selected through a merit-based competition, through a collaborative process involving expert evaluators in both countries. The deadline is January 6.

Harvard Medical School is holding a <u>Virtual Postdoctoral Recruitment Program</u> for a select group of PhD, MD, or MD/PhD students who are nearing the completion of – or who have recently completed – their studies, and are considering a postdoctoral position in biomedical sciences as the next stage in their career development.
