The <u>NIH Loan Repayment Programs (LRPs)</u> are a set of programs established by Congress and designed to recruit and retain highly qualified health professionals into biomedical research careers. The LRPs counteract that financial pressure by repaying up to \$100,000 (over two years) of a researcher's qualified educational debt in return for a commitment to engage in NIH mission-relevant research.

**Open Notebook** is partnering with the Burroughs Wellcome Fund to support eight-month, parttime fellowships for early-career science writers. Fellows will report and write six articles for the Open Notebook, participate in a professional discussion group, and receive a stipend of \$4,200.


