Then, you have to tell a story that convinces a judge or jury of your position by piecing all those bits of information together into something coherent and compelling. At each step along the way, a focus on audience and purpose is crucial. I also love crafting written arguments. It's a tremendous asset to be passionate about writing, because that's what takes up the majority of my time, and, in the end, it's really what clients are paying me to do.


