<b>Please provide the course description below:</b>	
<p>This Maymester course will immerse students in the performing arts traditions of Bali and the innovations that contemporary musicians and cultural workers create to help mitigate the negative impacts of tourism. Students will learn through a combination of lectures and hands-on workshops on gamelan, dance, and puppet theater led by local artists at the Mekar Bhuana Centre in Denpasar. In addition to the cultural immersion program, students will have a chance to learn about Mekar Bhuana's ongoing historical ethnographic work and projects that include reconstructing, restoring, and repatriating gamelan instruments. Excursions to a gamelan metalsmith and instrument maker, puppet museum, and temple ceremony will complement the hands-on workshops.</p> <p>Throughout the program, students will also learn about the challenges presented by cultural tourism and what Balinese organizers are doing to create a more equitable and sustainable arts industry. Since 2014, Mekar Bhuana has been partnering with local organizations such as the environmental group Trash Hero Kertalangu and Puspadi Bali, which helps empower people with disabilities through rehabilitation, education, and training programs. We will also explore how public discourse and government policies around women's emancipation have given rise to girls' and all-women gamelan ensembles that break the male-dominated tradition.
