

Annual Chemical Inventory Certification

All Vanderbilt University non-research departments in which there is potential for hazardous chemical exposure must verify the accuracy of their chemical inventories on the online safety data sheet (SDS) repository (EHSA) and submit this certification to Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) on an annual basis. The submittal of this certification is the responsibility of the Hazard Communication Coordinator for each department.

This certification ensures that hazardous chemical information is routinely updated in accordance with 29 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 1910.1200, Hazard Communication and Vanderbilt's Hazard Communication Program.
