



Student International Travel Checklist

Required Steps



VTRAC

- Record your travel with VTRAC at least 60 days prior to departure.
 - All students are **required** to record their travel with VTRAC



GeoBlue

- Enroll in a plan with GeoBlue for the duration of your travel
 - GeoBlue enrollment is **required** for students traveling abroad and cannot be waived



ANVIL

- Register your flights with Anvil at least 10 days prior to departure
 - Forward your original flight itinerary to VanderbiltTrip@anvilgroup.com



Travel Documents

- Check that your passport has **at least** six months of validity beyond return
 - US visa holders should contact [ISSS](#) for questions about returning to the US



Brightspace Course

- Complete the Health & Safety Pre-Departure Course in Brightspace
 - High-level review travelers will be automatically enrolled upon submission VTRAC
