

What is the Local Context Consultant Review Form?

This form applies to international research. The *International Research Consultant Form* intends to provide the VU HRPP with sufficient information regarding risks and benefits of the research occurring outside of the United States.

Who should complete this form?

The form must be completed by an individual who has competence in local cultural norms, regulations, policies, and/or the sociopolitical conditions where human subjects research is occurring and can attest to the research risks/benefits. It is recommended that the international research consultant not be on the study team.

When should this form be submitted?

[The expectation to submit this form varies by review level: The form is required for expedited and greater than minimal risk research. For exempt research, the VU HRPP may request the form upon the review of the submission at their discretion.]

If there is no formal Local Ethics Committee (LEC) review and approval required in the country(ies) where your study is occurring, please submit this completed form to the research team. The research team must submit the completed form in VERA (VU HRPP's electronic system) with your IRB submission.
